

Level 3 Award in Education and Training

Fact Sheet

Course Overview:

This Level 3 Award in Education and Training (RQF) has been designed to provide the knowledge skills and understanding required to work in an education setting as a supply or cover teacher.

This course also provides an introduction to teaching for individuals who would like to work or currently work within FE Colleges, Independent Training Providers and/or Local Authorities.

It can meet the needs of a range of trainee teachers, such as:

- Individuals wishing to work for Education Network
- Individuals not currently teaching or training – achievement of the qualification does not require practice other than microteaching
- Individuals currently teaching and training, including those new to the profession
- Individuals currently working as assessors, who wish to achieve a qualification that provides an introduction to teaching.

How Long will it take to achieve this qualification?

The recommended guided learning hours for this qualification is 48 hours. This is supplemented with directed learning.

Learning will be through a blended approach with some online taught hours with live tutors, some face-to-face learning and some directed study.

How is the qualification assessed?

This qualification is assessed by a portfolio of evidence which must cover all assessment criteria of the units selected. This includes written assessments and a 15 minute microteaching element. The portfolio of evidence will be assessed and internally quality assured by Thompson Team.

What next?

Learners will be designated a dedicated specialist recruitment consultant during the course who will advise on opportunities.
