- University based route- for primary/secondary teachers.
 - PGCE only
 - PGCE & QTS
 - Classroom experience-

minimum of 24 weeks


Reasons to apply for iQTS

- 1. On completion- You will automatically be awarded qualified teacher status (QTS)
- 2. You will gain the skills, experience and knowledge to become an excellent teacher, with an internationally transferable qualification backed by the UK government.
- 3. You can apply from anywhere in the world, as long as you meet the eligibility criteria.

Reasons to apply for iQTS

- 4. You will train to teach where you live or work, with no need to visit the UK.
- 5.Support with in-person support from a trained mentor.
- 6.If you come to England to teach, you'll benefit from
 - 1. a 2-year mentoring, training and induction period
 - 2. This will equip you to work in all English schools.
