INTRODUCTION

Eligibility to apply for QTS in ENGLAND

Non-UK teachers can now

- **▶QTS**: eligibility to apply for QTS using this service.
- ➤ Train to teach: complete initial teacher training in England
- ➤International qualified teacher status (iQTS): apply for international qualified teacher status (iQTS)

QTS EXEMPTIONS

QTS exemption for teachers from outside the UK

Qualified teachers from outside the UK are allowed to teach in England for up to 4 years without QTS To be eligible for **the 4-year rule**, you'll need to have:

- qualified as a teacher in a country outside the UK
- •successfully completed a course of teacher training recognised by the organisation that regulates teachers in the country where you qualified

PRIMARY ROUTE

Direct QTS Application for trained teachers

QTS ROUTE

AIM: to support the movement of well-qualified teachers to the English workforce.

ELIGIBLE NATIONALITIES

In addition, applicants with a subject specialism in languages, mathematics or science and a teaching qualification to teach 11 to 16 year olds from the following 7 countries will be able to use the service to check if they meet the requirements for QTS and apply:

- Jamaica
- ❖ Nigeria
- Singapore
- South Africa
- Zimbabwe

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE -1

Train to Teach (T-to-T)

TRAIN TO TEACH

Graduate entry route to teaching. You can train in a school or in a university setting, and study full-time (over a year) or part-time (over 2 or more years).

PGCE

Feepaying courses

- university teacher training programmes
- School Direct unsalaried teacher training
- school-centred initial teacher training (SCITT)

Salaried Courses*

- School Direct salaried teacher training programmes
- the Teach First Leadership Development programme
- postgraduate teaching

- •you studied a UK bachelor's degree, your education provider (such as your university or college)

- •study
- •bring your partner and children with you as your 'dependants', if they're eligible
- take on additional work in certain circumstances

SKILLED WORKER VISA

- arts and culture
- digital technology
- •You can live and work in the UK for up to 5 years at a time.

With an HPI visa you can:


- work in most jobs
